

Open house planned on Esky's power needs

ESCANABA — The city of Escanaba Electrical Advisory Committee has scheduled the first of a planned series of public open house meetings to discuss the future electrical power needs for Escanaba and options to meet those needs.

Two open house sessions are planned for Thursday at 2 and 6 p.m. in the city hall.

Each session will begin with a brief presentation and provide the same materials and opportunity for discussion.

“The open house sessions are intended to provide background information to area electric customers about the status of the Escanaba Energy Supply Project and provide an opportunity for public involvement in this important effort,” said Electric Advisory Committee chairman Tony Westerberg.

The primary purpose of the Escanaba Energy Supply Project is to develop a future electric supply plan to provide reliable and economic electric power to all customers of the Escanaba Electric Department.
